## Introduction

The Medical Council of Canada (MCC) was established in 1912 under the Canada Medical Act. The MCC offers a series of examinations to assess the competence of trained physicians wishing to practise medicine in Canada and confers on those who meet its standard the title of Licentiate of the Medical Council of Canada. In addition, the MCC maintains a national registry of physicians and their qualifications and offers an online portal where physicians can manage their credentials and apply for medical licensure in the various Canadian jurisdictions. The MCC also initiates and promotes research and development in the evaluation of medical knowledge and competence.

## Project

The MCC strives to provide useful performance feedback to candidates following each examination. To this end, it recently revised the Supplemental Feedback Report it provides to all candidates with the aim of providing more concise and focused information. Key to this effort was a series of graphs summarizing the candidate's performance in several categories compared with the performance of a standard cohort.

The Supplemental Feedback Report is a PDF document produced using SQL Server Reporting Services. We needed a solution that could produce a bar graph with overlaid SEM bars. After some research, we determined that Nevron Chart for SSRS was the right fit, allowing us to easily produce a graph such as this.




Figure 3. MCCEE Score Profile: Your performance by Discipline
